

# Minutes

## NEW BERLIN SAFETY COMMISSION

September 13, 2000 7:30 p.m.

**Meeting called to order:** Called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Chairman Polczynski

**Present:** Randy Alf, Ted Wysocki, Jim Polczynski, Steve Bartelt, Deb Schenk, Kory Hauser, and Tony Goedheer. Also present: Alderman Rush Wilkens

**Excused/Absent:** Bill Dunn, Jeff Chase, Don Ullman, and Ken Czyzewski

**Communications:** Letter from County Supervisor Vera Stroud regarding the cost and installation of traffic signals at Moorland Rd. and Howard Ave.

**Approval of Minutes:** Motion by Steve Bartelt to approve the August 9, 2000 minutes. Seconded by Ted Wysocki and carried unanimously.

### Old Business:

02 00 02 Buena Park Subdivision - Concerns about speeding and increased traffic due to Greenfield Ave. construction. An update on Greenfield Ave. construction indicates that they will be working expeditiously to get the Calhoun Rd. and Moorland Rd. intersections completed. This should help to alleviate some of the high traffic volumes. This item should remain on the agenda.

01 00 01 Coachlight Dr., west of Carriage Ln. - Posting of "No Parking " on one side of the street. The signs have been posted. **Motion** by Ted Wysocki to drop this item from the agenda. Seconded by Jim Polczynski and carried unanimously.

02 00 06 Balboa Dr. and Woodfield Ln. - Safety concerns for children and drivers in the area due to the blind, uncontrolled intersection. Engineering staff will look at the intersection to determine if "Yield" signs would be appropriate. Hold this item on the agenda for further study.

01 00 07 Fremont Ln. & Mark Dr. - Request for a "Yield" sign for southbound Fremont Ln.

A "Stop" sign has been authorized by the Common Council, per last month's recommendation by, and is already in place. **Motion** by Randy Alf to drop this item from the agenda. Seconded by Steve Bartelt and carried unanimously.

02 00 07 Calhoun Farms - Safety concerns due to Greenfield Ave. construction. Traffic has increased and many cars are speeding; would like a sign for "No Through Traffic." The Commission does not feel that "No Through Traffic" signs should be placed. The Police Dept. will continue enforcement efforts and this item will remain on the agenda for the Commission to monitor the situation.

03 00 07 Graylog Ln. and Ronke Ln. - Request from neighborhood citizens to remove "Stop" sign from this intersection; replace with a "Yield" sign. The stop sign has now been replaced with a yield sign. **Motion** by Kory Hauser to remove this item from the agenda. Seconded by Deb Schenk and carried unanimously.

01 00 08 Ohio Dr., between Hickory Rd. and Russel Rd. – Vehicles speeding and not stopping for stop signs. The Police Dept. will continue enforcement efforts. The Commission does not recommend speed

bumps. **Motion** by Jim Polczynski to drop this item from the agenda. Seconded by Steve Bartelt and carried unanimously. Randy Alf will contact the concerned parties.

02 00 08 Woodshire Dr., between Lincoln Ave. and Rogers Dr. – Request for Police monitoring of vehicle speed. The Police Dept. will monitor and take enforcement action. **Motion** by Ted Wysocki to have the Police Dept. continue to monitor the area and to put this area on the list for the KKAD25 program. This item can be removed from the agenda. Seconded by Jim Polczynski and carried unanimously.

03 00 08 Forest Point Blvd. & Hunter Ln. – Request for stop signs. The Police Dept. survey indicated that speeding was not a problem. They will continue to monitor periodically. The Commission will hold this item on the agenda, pending input from the Engineering staff regarding a possible stop sign.

04 00 08 Arcadian Dr. & Meadow Ln. – Request for stop signs and traffic enforcement. It appears that speeding does occur occasionally, however, the Police Dept. will monitor the situation periodically. It does appear though that there are some sight problems at this intersection that may warrant the placement of stop signs. The Commission is recommending that the Engineering Dept. look into seeing if stop signs are warranted. Hold this item on the agenda for further study.

05 00 08 Ranch Rd. (1500 S. block) – Request for no parking signs and traffic enforcement due to increased traffic caused by the Greenfield Ave. construction. The Police Dept. has studied the area. Traffic has increased and there were a few speeders. They will spot-check the area with traffic enforcement. The "No Parking" signs are not warranted at this time. **Motion** by Randy Alf to drop this item from the agenda. Seconded by Jim Polczynski and carried unanimously. Randy Alf will update Alderman Bullermann about the situation.

06 00 08 Calhoun Rd. & Cleveland Ave. – Traffic light timing. Hold this item on the agenda for further study.

07 99 01 Installation of OPTICON at traffic light controlled intersections. (Tabled 5/10/00)

**New Business :**

03 00 06 Keep Kid Alive – Drive 25 (Revisited) Alderman Wilkens gave a report on the KKAD25 program. He said that a committee will be formed and they will keep the Safety Commission informed on it. Hold this item on the agenda.

01 00 09 Clubhouse Dr. & Lincoln Ave. – Request for a stop sign on Clubhouse at Lincoln. A question was raised as to whether Clubhouse Dr. is a private drive or a public roadway. The Commission will study this further. Hold this item on the agenda.

Motion by Jim Polczynski to adjourn the meeting at 8:25 p.m. Seconded by Randy Alf and carried unanimously.
