➤ **Proposed 2007 CIP Budget**

Mayor Chiovaturo indicated this will be on the next agenda because no action was taken.

Mayor Chiovaturo indicated we can discuss the proposed budget however if we amend we need to publish a public hearing notice within 10 days with a new date. The Mayor compared what his city tax would be for his home if located in other surrounding cities. The range went from over \$1,100 to \$73 higher than the City of New Berlin.

Alderman Hopkins thanked the staff and indicated a good job was done by all. Thanked everyone for being here for 3 nights.

Alderman Gallagher indicated the unrest with the tax levy is going across the state. We are doing our job of controlling the levy. But perhaps we are getting a little short sighted.

Alderman Moore cautioned that over \$500,000 was taken out. The Departments have cut in response to our cuts.
