
## NBPD Monthly Update – June 2025

**NEW BERLIN POLICE CRIME STATISTICS:** In May of 2025, the New Berlin Police Department initiated or responded to **2472 calls for service**. The below graphs represent primary categories during this reporting period in which our patrol division allocated resources. The graphs (3-year comparisons) are categorized into four types of Calls for Service (CFS): Crimes Against Person, Property Crime, Alcohol & Drug Activity and Citizen Welfare Assessments.







**WELL-BEING CHECKS:** The graph below captures the number of calls for service involving well-being assessments and two of the potential dispositions related to this type of call for service, a referral to the Aging & Disability Resource Center (ADRC) of Waukesha County and Protective Custody under WI Statute chapter 51. ADRC referrals are resources allocated for adults aged 60 and above, caregivers, adults with physical or developmental disabilities (to include dementia) and adults with mental health or substance use concerns. Chapter 51 protective placement is an “emergency detention” of patients in need of immediate care primarily due to self-harm or other destructive behavior.



**REFERRALS FOR CRIMINAL PROSECUTION:** In May of 2025, the New Berlin PD referred 58 charges involving adult & Juvenile offenders to the Waukesha County District Attorney's Office for case review, reference misdemeanor or felony prosecution. Additionally, 16 criminal traffic citations were issued.



**REFERRALS FOR MUNICIPAL PROSECUTION:** In May of 2025, the New Berlin PD issued a total of 380 municipal citations for non-criminal prosecution in New Berlin Municipal Court. 325 citations were traffic related, 45 citations were non-traffic related & 10 citations were for impaired driving (Operating While Intoxicated, Operating w/ a Prohibited Alcohol Content or Operating w/ a Restricted Controlled Substance.)



**SHARPS & RX/OTC DISPOSAL:** In partnership with Froedtert, the NBPd participates in annual spring (April) and fall (October) drug collection events. Should you miss your opportunity to dispose of your unwanted medications or sharps at one of these events, there are year-round disposal options available to you. ## 3 Steps: Prepare your medical sharps for safe disposal

To help reduce the risk of injury, follow these steps to correctly package your used medical sharps for safe disposal.

### 1. Place the sharps in rigid, puncture-resistant containers that have secure lids or caps.

**NOTE: DO NOT** add bleach to the container. Bleach may not completely disinfect needles, and it could spill and injure you or the people who handle the waste.

Acceptable containers include:

- Commercially available sharps containers
- Thick-walled plastic detergent or bleach bottles with screw caps

Unacceptable containers include:

- Coffee cans (the lids are too easily punctured)
- Plastic milk jugs
- Plastic bags
- Aluminum cans
- Soda bottles

### 2. Visibly label the sharps container with one of the following:

- Biohazard
- Infectious waste
- Sharps
- Bio-hazard emblem

If you have put sharps in a recyclable container, label it “do not recycle.” When the container is full, sealed and labeled, store it out of reach of children. Dispose of it properly at a sharps collection station.

**NEW BERLIN RECYCLING CENTER:** With spring clean-up ramping up, so are the number of visitors at our amazing recycling center. Last year, we had over 100,000 residents take advantage of dropping off refuse and yard waste. On behalf of the recycling center staff, we ask that you practice patience and adhere to established regulations for the safety of everyone. Staff are truly working their hardest to minimize wait-time during your visit! During your visit at the recycling center, please drive extra carefully, have your ID ready to present to staff for proof of residency, do not engage in threatening or disorderly behavior towards staff or other visitors and ensure you DO NOT mix any items such as scrap metal, chains or concrete in with your yard waste. (Pictured are some of the scrap metal items staff recovered with discarded yard waste.) This will cause damage to City property and negatively impact recycling center operations for all users. The NBPD will continue to actively work with recycling center staff to ensure visitor and staff safety. ## **2025 NEW BERLIN POLICE MIDNIGHT VOLLEYBALL**


*CHECK-IN STARTS AT 7:30PM, TOURNAMENT PLAY BEGINS AT 8:00PM*
